PRESENTER: Phil Chalmers is a true crime writer, law enforcement trainer, youth culture specialist, and a television personality. He is the author of several books, including Inside the Mind of a Teen Killer and True Lies. He has been researching homicide and interviewing offenders for 30 years, and his work has been featured on dozens of television shows and networks including A&E's "Killer Kids" and Fox's "Crime Watch Daily." He has interviewed over 200 killers face to face, including teen killers, school shooters, mass murderers and serial killers. His current project is a book and television show about serial killers and solving cold cases. He resides in Sarasota, Florida, and is married to a middle school teacher named Wendi.

Chalmers will be addressing the causes, warning signs and triggers of teen killers, school shooters, mass murderers and serial killers. In a fast-paced and hard-hitting training style, he will discuss dozens of cases and display hundreds of crime scene photos and videos.
